

## Scrappy Star Block

The scrappier, the better! Even the background can be scrappy-different fabrics of the same color and/or value.

For each 12-1/2" square block you will need
$16-2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ print squares (for your 16-patch center)
$12-2-1 / 2^{"}$ background squares of very light print(s), like white, cream, ivory, beige.
$8-2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ half square triangles, half print $\&$ half background

1. Create a 16-patch center with four rows of 4 print squares each.
2. Create 4 side sections, each a row of 2 background squares with a half square triangle at either end. Background side of half square triangle faces background squares.

3. Add a background square to either end of two of the side sections.

4. Sew shorter side sections (from step 2) to opposite sides of 16 -patch center.
5. Sew longer side sections (from step 3) to remaining opposite sides of 16 -patch center.
6. Voila! A scrappy star!!

## Notes:

a. Sew blocks together until quilt top is desired size. Sashing optional. Borders optional.
b. Any size square can be used ( $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}, 2^{\prime \prime}$, etc.) as long as all are the same size.
c. Would love to see this tried with a very dark background, like black, brown, navy, eggplant, forest green.
