

Perfect Set-in Circles by Machine Supply List

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Basic sewing supplies

Sewing machine

Elmer's Washable School glue stick (Michael's or Hobby Lobby)

Freezer paper cut into one 14 ½" square, one 10 ½" square and one 8" square

Background cut into one 14 ½" square, one 10 ½" square and one 8" square

Circle fabric cut into squares roughly, 9 ½", 6", and 4"

Pencil If your background fabric is very dark, you need a silver or white pencil also

Compass

Long straight edge (24" x 6" ruler is perfect)

Paper scissors

Sewing scissors

Iron and ironing surface (optional)

Knee lift lever if your sewing machine has one

Before you come to class be sure to cut your freezer paper squares, your background fabric squares, and the squares that will become your circles. This will allow you to use your class more efficiently.
